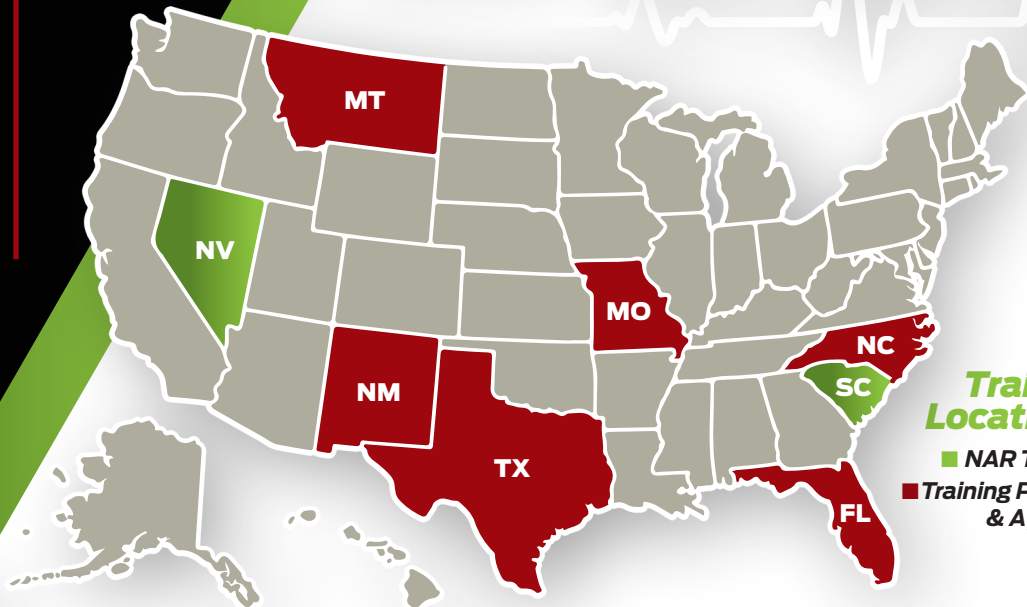
North American Rescue Education and Training (NAR Training)

COURSE Descriptions

PUBLIC ACCESS BLEEDING CONTROL

➤ **NAR Bleeding Control (BCON)**

6-hour course oriented towards **civilians**. Students are exposed to realistic trauma scenarios and taught how to treat major hemorrhaging injuries, receiving critical knowledge on how respond to preventable bleeding deaths prior to arrival of EMS. **Stop the Bleed certification** issued upon completion.

➤ **First Responder - Work Place Safety**

8-hour course designed for **civilians**. Students will learn CPR, bleeding control, and basic first aid to the most common workplace injuries. **AHA BLS** and **NAR First Responder certification** upon successful test completion.

➤ **Civilian Medical**

3-day medical course designed for **civilians**. Students will learn basic emergency medicine, med bag packing, and med supply procurement. **AHA BLS** and **NAEMT TECC certification** upon successful test completion.

➤ **First Responder - Trauma Care**

8-hour course for **law enforcement** and **first responders** that will provide students the ability and confidence to apply trauma care in the field. Upon completion of testing, students receive **NAEMT TECC** certification.

NATIONAL REGISTRY

IBSC

➤ **NAR C3**

42-hour in-house course for IBSC critical care course certification or re-certification (FP-C or CCP-C) and national registry re-certification. Students will learn or refresh all skills and knowledge needed to certify/re-certify, and will earn **42 hours** of IBSC and **National Registry Continuing Education.**

➤ **Vent Hero**

Supporting literature that provides an **introduction** into the theory of **successful ventilation management** geared towards the **critical care provider** and **clinician** responsible for managing complex patient ventilation support.

➤ **Essentials In Critical Care 4.0**

Online refresher course which exceeds the minimum requirements (**above 16 hrs**) for approved IBSC certifications.

➤ **EMT Hybrid**

Self-paced (over period of one year), online learning designed to prepare **entry-level student** for written and practical application testing for **National EMT testing and certification.**

➤ **AEMT Hybrid**

Self-paced (over period of one year), online learning designed to prepare **EMT student** for written and practical application testing for **National AEMT testing and certification.**



LAW ENFORCEMENT

➤ **TECC-LE**

8-hour course specifically designed for **law enforcement.** Covers hemorrhage control, airway control, splinting, extraction techniques, and stop the bleed scenarios. Upon passing test, students receive **NAEMT TECC-LE certification.**

➤ **FEDMED**

5-day course designed specifically for **federal law enforcement officers.** Students learn how to diagnose and treat various illnesses and injuries utilizing role players and simulations. Upon successful completion, **AHA BLS** and **NAEMT TECC certifications** are achieved. Also, for **EMTs**, this course also serves as a **full EMT re-certification.**

MILITARY

➤ TCCC-AC

This **40-hour** course is designed for **non-medical military personnel** that provides a **4 year NAEMT TCCC certification** upon completion. Students will learn emergency battlefield medicine focusing on preventable causes of death.

➤ TCCC-MP

This **16-hour** course is designed for **non-medical military personnel** that provides a **4-year NAEMT TCCC certification** upon completion. Includes standard training with addition of scenarios utilizing role players and moulage.

➤ EGT-AC

This **5-day** course is designed for **small military units** that provides a **4-year NAEMT TCCC-AC certification**. Provides students with TCCC medicine and drills, field maneuvers, and trauma lanes with role players and CASEVAC trainers.

➤ EGT-MP

This **5-day** course is designed for **military medical provider units** that awards a **4-year NAEMT TCCC-AC certification** upon completion. Provides students with TCCC medicine and drills, field maneuvers, and trauma lanes with role players and CASEVAC trainers.

➤ SOFMED

This **8-day** course is specifically designed for **Special Operations Medics** that provides the following certifications: **BLS, ACLS, PALS, TCCC-MP**, and a **full NCCP 60-hour CEU/NRP refresher**. Students focus on medicine while enhancing tactics via use of simulations, role players, and trainers.

➤ SOTM

This **8-day** course is specifically designed for **Special Operations Medics** that provides the following certifications: **BLS, ACLS, PALS, TCCC-MP**, and a **full NCCP 60-hour CEU/NRP refresher**. Students focus on medicine while enhancing tactics via use of perfused cadavers, simulations, role players, and trainers.

CP MED

➤ Toxic MED 101

2-day course for **anyone** who may be involved in a **CBRN incident**. Students will receive critical knowledge and skills on how to respond to incidents involving chemical/ biological/ radiological/nuclear contaminants. **NAEMT TECC certification** awarded upon completion.

➤ Toxic MED 201

5-day course designed for **medical providers/first responders**. Provides background, knowledge and methodologies associated with responding to or supporting CBRN operations with casualties. Students will have the opportunity to receive the **AHLS certification** if desired. All students will earn **NAEMT TECC certification** upon successful completion.

ADVANCED

➤ Austere Rescue Course

5-day course aimed at **military medical providers** and **paramedics**. Students will receive periods of instruction covering austere medicine, remote rescue, and patient transport in rugged terrain with limited resources. Course will involve treatment and movement in remote environments coupled with challenging problems involving emergency medicine, transport, and elements of PCC.

➤ Austere Surgical Course

5-day course exclusively designed for **military surgical teams**. Students will utilize perfused cadavers to hone surgical skills in a variety of environments; battlefield conditions and equipment will be incorporated into training to increase proficiency and team skills. SOPs will be tested in preparation for full mission profile event.

➤ Prolonged Critical Care

5-day course that gives **military medical providers** the knowledge and skills necessary to treat patients in an austere environment for longer periods of time with limited resources when patient evacuation is not tenable. Students will be instructed on how to keep patients stable with whatever resources are available until transport arrives.
