The USO will mail the book and video to the family at home. The family is then encouraged to take a picture of the child watching the video and send that picture to the service member.

"(The USO)...significantly enhances the quality of life for our Soldiers and Sailors training here at Camp McCrady" said Col Mark G. Dykes, South Carolina Army National Guard (SCARNG) Garrison Commander. "It also improves the quality of life for family members back home, too; and that enables the service members to focus more clearly on their training when they know everything back at home is running smoothly."
