## NORTH AMERICAN RESCUE VETERAN'S DAY CEREMONY DEDICATES "CARE UNDER FIRE"

*Greer, SC (November 11, 2009)* – In spite of the stormy weather, a brief ceremony was held inside the corporate offices of North American Rescue, LLC to commemorate Veteran's Day and to dedicate the monument that honors those who have served and are serving our country. The recently commissioned original bronze by renowned sculptor Jeff Buccacio was central to the festivities as it dramatically portrays the chronicle of battle and the drive to save the life of a wounded comrade. The 7 foot tall monument stands as a constant reminder of the bravery and sacrifice of the American Soldier.

At 11:11 a.m. the service began with the Air Force Junior ROTC Unit from Byrnes High School in Duncan, SC serving as the color guard. The 13 cadets and 2 instructors were honored guests as they played a pivotal role by proudly displaying the flags throughout the ceremony. Additionally, newly appointed NAR president Samuel D. Wyman III gave a brief speech reminding the NAR staff of the honored role they play in helping to save the lives of those who so bravely put themselves in harm's way.

The aptly named monument, "Care Under Fire", which is prominently stationed at the entry way of NAR's corporate headquarters, was dedicated with the following statement:

"Erected in front of the North American Rescue offices and dedicated this 11th day of the 11th month in the year 2009, this monument serves to remind all who view it of the heroic bravery and selfless sacrifices that our American Warfighters have made in the pursuit of freedom. Commissioned from sculptor Jeff Buccacio, this original work of art is dedicated to reminding members of North American Rescue of their continued vision to support the American Warfighter with products designed to increase survivability in austere environments."
