North American Rescue, Inc. (NAR) and National Tactical Officers Association (NTOA) collaborated with The Medical College of Georgia Center of Operational Medicine to improve tactical medical training. The result—the STORMTM initiative. The Specialized Tactics for Operational Medicine debuted in a demonstration at the NTOA 25th Anniversary Conference in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Center of Operational Medicine Director Dr. Phillip Coule says, "Because tactical scenarios can change at any second, treatment options during those situations can also change. By imitating wartime military techniques, the STORMTM initiative presents rescue strategies for tactical officers. The program offers training and support for officers, tactical commanders, and medical personnel involved in tactical law enforcement operations.
