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## NORTH AMERICAN RESCUE WINS MILITARY CONTRACT

North American Rescue, Inc. won a five-year, \$31.9 million contract to supply the United States Army, Air Force, Navy, and Marine Corp with litters, medical kits, and accessories.

Large quantities of backpacks, called Warrior Aid and Litter Kits or WALKs, meticulously packed with 45 items, ship out each day, some directly to Iraq. Providing necessary equipment to manage combat injuries until the wounded soldier can reach a medical treatment facility, these WALKs contain everything from dressings and tourniquets to splints and needles, with a strong, light-weight litter slipped down the middle. Everything is in quick-release packing and arranged in the same order for quick access.

"If any one of the components is not done correctly, it could mean disaster on the battlefield," said Jim Carino, chief operating officer for NAR.

North American Rescue recognized that winning this contract will give them the opportunity to achieve an immediate and vast impact in the War on Terror by saving American soldier's lives. Use of North American Rescue's products could reduce preventable deaths by 60-90%.
